

RESOLVE authorizing the Governor and Council to accept, in the name of the State, from the Pemaquid Monument Association, title to Fort William Henry and adjacent Lands.

Resolved. That the governor and council are hereby author2 ized in the name of the State to accept from the Pemaquid
3 Monument Association, a corporation established by law,
4 all their property consisting of the remains of Fort William
5 Henry and adjacent lands with rights of way, lying and sit6 uate in the town of Bristol in the county of Lincoln, so soon
7 as such conveyance may be made in manner and form ap8 proved by the attorney general, and to hold the said premises
9 and property as a public reservation forever and to make
10 such provisions as they may deem advisable for the custody
11 and care of the same for historical purposes.
