STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the Inhabitants of the Town of Woolwich or their Assigns to increase the Height of the Dam across Nequasset Stream in the Town of Woolwich.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The inhabitants of the town of Woolwich, their
2 successors or assigns are hereby authorized to build, raise
3 and maintain the dam across Nequasset stream in said Wool-
4 wich five feet above its present height and to flow lands
5 adjoining said stream and Nequasset lake. Provided that
6 said flowage shall in no way injure, impair or interfere with
7 the use of the pumping station of the Maine Water Com-
8 pany as now or hereafter established at said Nequasset lake.

Sect. 2. Said inhabitants of the town of Woolwich, their
2 successors or assigns shall pay all damages that shall be

3 sustained by any persons by flowage; and if any person
4 sustains damages as aforesaid and the amount thereof cannot
5 be mutually agreed upon, such person may cause his dam-
6 age to be assessed in the same manner and under the same
7 conditions, restrictions and limitations as are by law pre-
8 scribed in the case of damages by the laying out of highways.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
