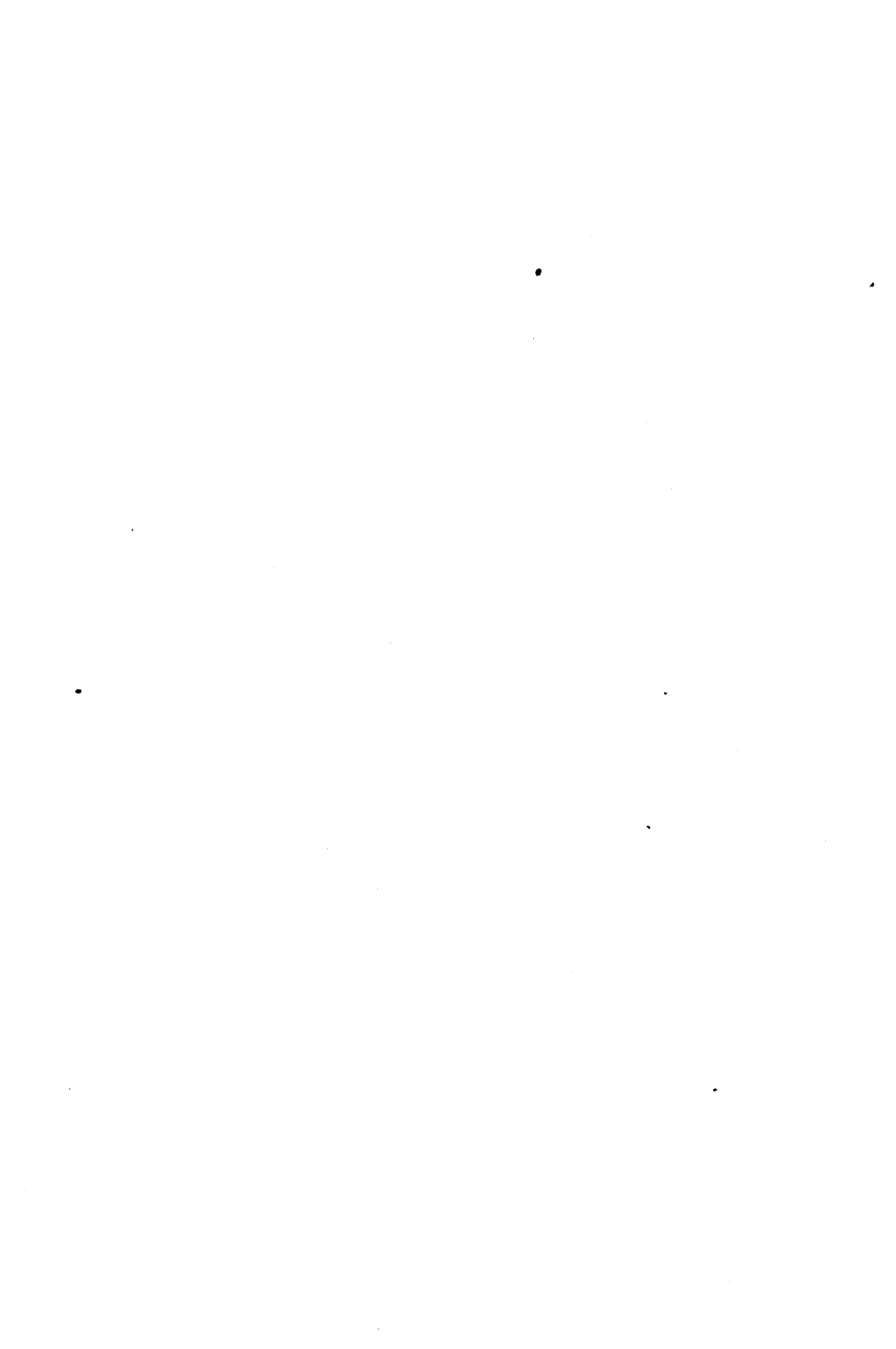

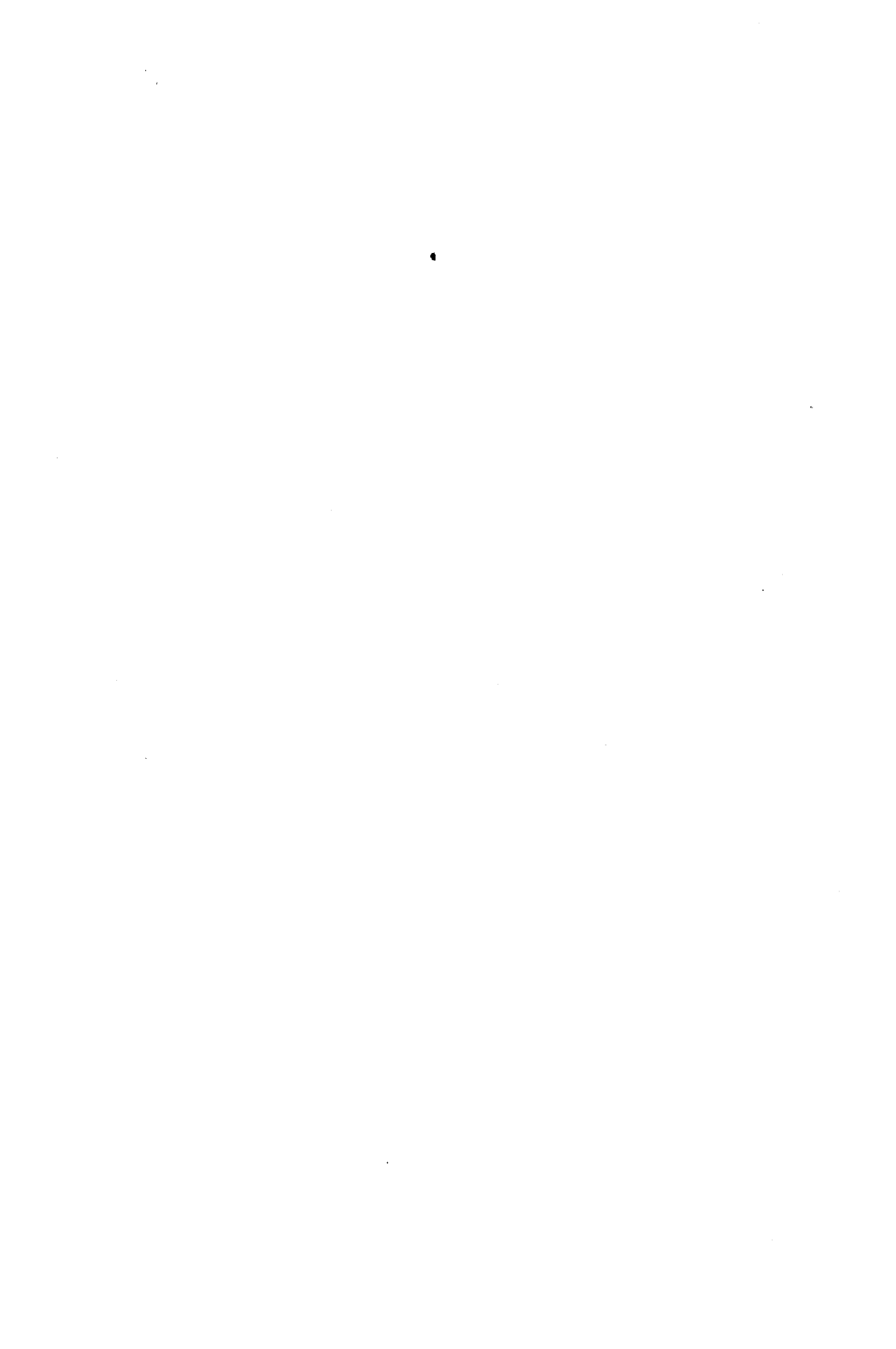
AN ACT to render optional the use of seals on deeds and other
contracts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. All deeds, bonds, and other contracts now re-
2 quired by law to be under seal, or purporting to be under seal,
3 shall be valid when signed and delivered, although no seal is
4 affixed thereto.

Section 2. The action of assumpsit may be maintained for
2 breach of any written contract.
