STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to re-establish the Salary of the Judge and Register of
Probate for Somerset County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. From and after the first day of January, in the
2 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine,
3 the salary of the judge of probate for Somerset county shall be
4 four hundred dollars a year.

Sect. 2. From and after the first day of January, in the year
2 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine, the
3 salary of the register of probate for Somerset county shall be five
4 hundred dollars a year.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are
2 hereby repealed.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
