IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT  
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

---

AN ACT to locate Androscoggin Pond in some County and Town.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. That the west line of the town of Wayne and the  
2 west line of the county of Kennebec shall be as now established  
3 by law, except they shall follow the westerly shore of Androscog-  
4 gin pond from the point where said lines running south now  
5 strike the northerly end of said pond, to the point where the  
6 line between Leeds and Wayne strikes the southerly end of said  
7 pond.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
