STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section four, of chapter one hundred and fifteen, of the Revised Statutes, relating to the Register of Probate in Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. On and after the first day of January in the year 2 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine, the 3 salary of the register of probate of the county of Lincoln shall be 4 seven hundred dollars per annum, instead of the sum now estab- 5 lished by law.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

The reason for asking the enactment of the above amendment is that the passage of National Insolvent Law as enacted during the past year, has taken from the county courts all the insolvent matters, thus materially affecting the salary in question, as insolvent business was paid entirely by fees.
