RESOLVE in favor Adjutant General John T. Richards.

Recognizing the conspicuous and untiring services of the Hon.
2 John T. Richards, Adjutant General of Maine, under circum-
3 stances requiring a routine of duty far beyond the ordinary or
4 contemplated demands of his office,

Resolved, That there be paid to John T. Richards, Adjutant
6 General, for each of the years 1898 and 1899, in addition to his
7 present salary and in full for extra services the sum of five hun-
8 dred dollars, the same to be paid out of the appropriation for
9 military purposes on warrant drawn by the governor.
