AN ACT to prevent Heads of Departments from employing Counsel Witnesses before Committees of the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

No head of any department shall hereafter employ counsel 2 or witnesses, at the expense of the State, to appear before any 3 committee of the legislature without the consent of the legis-4 lature.
