STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT in relation to Political Caucuses in Towns.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The town committees of any political party are
2 hereby authorized to fix the time and place of, and call all town
3 caucuses of their respective parties; provided, however, that
4 such call shall be by public notice posted in conspicuous places
5 in the town where such caucus is to be held, at least four days
6 before the holding of such caucus.

Sect. 2. In any call for a caucus as provided for by this act,
2 the committee calling the same shall designate in the call the
3 time when the polls for receiving votes shall be opened, and the
4 polls in all cases shall remain open not less than thirty minutes,

5 nor shall the polls remain open more than four hours, unless by
6 vote of the caucus.

Sect. 3. This act shall not be construed as effecting the pro-
2 visions of chapter three hundred and ten of the Public Laws of
3 eighteen hundred and ninety-seven.
