STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to provide means for Examination of Claims for
State Pension.

Resolved, That the State Pension clerk is hereby authorized
2 to expend such sum under the direction of the Governor and
3 Council, not exceeding three hundred dollars yearly, as may
4 be necessary to properly examine the claims presented to his
5 office, the same to be paid out of the appropriation for State
6 pensions for the years eighteen hundred ninety-nine and
7 nineteen hundred.
