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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT  
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

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AN ACT to authorize the town of Damariscotta to Fund its  
Indebtedness at Maturity and to issue new Bonds.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The town of Damariscotta is hereby authorized  
2 to fund its indebtedness at maturity and for this purpose to  
3 issue bonds, in such form and amount, and with such rate of  
4 interest, and payable at such times and in such manner as  
5 shall be determined by vote of said town, under a proper  
6 article in the warrant at a legal town meeting.

Sect. 2. To carry into effect the provisions of this act,  
2 said town is hereby authorized to pass such votes as may be  
3 deemed necessary and proper, to enter into and make any  
4 contract or agreement not inconsistent with the laws of this  
5 State.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
