### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to repeal so much of section V of chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes as relates to the Bounty on Bears.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Strike of section 5 of chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes 2 after the word wolf the words "and bear" so that said sec-3 tion as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 5. A bounty of five dollars for every wolf killed 5 in any town shall be paid by the treasurer thereof to the 6 person killing it upon compliance with the following conditions.'
