STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the Construction of a Dam at the Outlet of the Mill Pond at New Harbor in the Town of Bristol.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Lyman W. Hanna and William Mears, Jr., their heirs, suc2 cessors and assigns are hereby authorized and emprowered
3 to build and maintain a dam at the outlet of the raill pond,
4 so called, at New Harbor in the town of Briscol, and use
5 said mill pond as a lobster pound, so far ar such use does
6 not conflict with the fish and game laws now existing or
7 hereafter enacted. There shall be a suitable waterway in
8 said dam to admit from time to tirde the inflow and outflow
9 of tide water, and the purity of the water and a cleanly con10 dition of the shores of said mill pond shall be preserved.
