STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and sixty-nine of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and sixtyseven, relating to the Mattawamkeag Log Driving Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section three of chapter one hundred sixty-nine 2 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and 3 sixty-seven, is hereby repealed.
- Sect. 2. Said chapter one hundred sixty-nine is further 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 'Sect. 3. The Mattawamkeag Log Driving Company is 4 required to drive logs which from time to time may come 5 into the Jellerson and Ox-bow booms; but logs which from

- 6 time to time may come into Scatterack boom shall not be 7 turned out until the water in the Mattawamkeag and Penob-8 scot rivers is at a pitch suitable for sorting out and separat-9 ing logs of different owners at their several places of destination on said rivers.'
 - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
