### STATE OF MAINE.

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT additional to the incorporation of The Ellsworth Electric Illuminating Company and additional to the Charter of the Ellsworth Water Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Sect. 1. The Ellsworth Electric Illuminating Company is
- 2 hereby authorized to issue its bonds for refunding its outstand-
- 3 ing bonds and for corporation purposes, in a sum not exceedin
- 4 twenty-five thousand dollars for a time not exceeding twenty
- 5 years, and upon such rates of interest as said company may
- 6 deem expedient, and may secure the same by mortgage of the
- 7 franchises and property of the said corporation.

And the Ellsworth Water Company is hereby authorized to 9 guaranty, assume and pay said bonds and all outstanding 10 contracts, obligations and liabilities of said The Ellsworth Electric Illuminating Company, upon such terms as said companies 12 may mutually determine.

Sect. 2. The Ellsworth Water Company is hereby authorized 2 to purchase, hold, own and enjoy the franchises, property, 3 shares of stock, rights, easements, privileges and immunities of 4 the said The Ellsworth Electric Illuminating Company, and the 5 said The Ellsworth Electric Illuminating Company is hereby 6 authorized to sell, transfer and convey its franchise, property, 7 shares of stock, rights, easements, privileges and immunities, 8 to said Ellsworth Water Company, and upon such terms as said 9 water company and said Illuminating Company may determine; 10 and upon such purchase, sale and transfer the said Ellsworth 11 Water Company shall succeed to and have, hold and enjoy all 12 the rights, easements, privileges and immunities heretofore or 13 hereafter granted to said Illuminating Company in the city of 14 Ellsworth, in the county of Hancock, and shall thereupon and 15 thereafter have the right and power to supply said city of Ells-16 worth and the inhabitants thereof with light, heat and power by 17 the manufacture and distribution of gas and electricity, and 18 have all the powers and privileges and be subjected to all the 19 duties, restrictions and liabilities by law incident to such 20 corporations.

The said Ellsworth Water Company, upon such purchase 22 and transfer, is authorized to make contracts with the United 23 States, with the county of Hancock, with the said city 24 of Ellsworth, with corporations, and the inhabitants of said

25 city of Ellsworth, for the purpose of supplying light, heat and 26 power; and the said county of Hancock, by its board of county 27 commissioners, and the said city of Ellsworth, by its mayor and 28 aldermen, are authorized to contract with said company from 29 time to time as they may deem expedient.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
