STATEMENT OF FACTS

This institution was founded some twenty years ago. In 1888, it opened a hospital, where hundreds of patients have been received ever since. During the last year, it received 299 patients. These patients came from all over the state. As it is well known, the hospital is under the care of the "Sisters of Charity" and is very well managed. It has one of the most able staffs of surgeons and physicians in the state. It is open to everybody, rich or poor and the poor especially have found an asylum where they receive the best of care. Notwithstanding, the regularly appointed staff of physicians and surgeons, any responsible physician is admitted to the hospital and can take care of his patients without intervention from anybody.
