STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to extend the Charter of the Winn Water and Power
Company, and to amend the same.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Winn
2 Water and Power Company which were granted by chapter
3 one hundred forty-five of the Private and Special Laws of
4 1895 are hereby extended and the persons named in said act,
5 their associates and successors, shall have all the rights, pow-
6 ers and privileges that were granted them by said act, to be
7 exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as
8 specified in said act; and the organization of said corporation
9 as now existing is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Sect. 2. Section six of said chapter one hundred forty-five
2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following words :
3 'and to locate; erect and maintain in said river above said
4 dam and below the mouth of the Mattawamkeag river piers
5 and booms for the purpose of collecting and holding logs and
6 other lumber coming down said river and destined for use and
7 manufacture at said Winn, provided, that said piers and booms
8 are so located and erected that they will not impede the passage
9 of other logs and lumber down said river;' so that said sec-
10 tion, as amended, shall read as follows :

'Sect. 6. Said company is authorized to lay and maintain its
12 pipes under, in and over the Penobscot river, and to build and
13 maintain all necessary structures therefor, and to locate, erect
14 and maintain in said river above said dam and below the
15 mouth of the Mattawamkeag river, piers and booms for the
16 purpose of collecting and holding logs and other lumber coming
17 down said river and destined for use and manufacture at said
18 Winn, provided, that said piers and booms are so located and
19 erected that they will not impede the passage of other logs and
20 lumber down said river.'

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
