STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section 44 of chapter 2 of the Revised
Statutes, relating to the Distribution of Printed Copies of the
Public Laws.

*'Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 44 of chapter 2 of the Revised Statutes
2 is hereby amended, by adding after the word, "subscribers"
3 in the fourth line, and the word "distributed" in the fifth
4 line, the words, 'within the State,' so that said section shall
5 read as follows:

'Sect. 44. He shall cause the public laws passed at each
7 session to be printed within thirty days after the close thereof,
8 on extra sheets, on good paper, by the publishers of each

9 newspaper ; and each printer who so publishes and distributes
10 the laws to his subscribers within the State, shall receive
11 ten dollars, besides one dollar for every hundred copies so
12 distributed within the State. He shall also procure the usual
13 number of each volume of Maine Reports and distribute
14 them and the acts and resolves when published, to such cor-
15 porations, officers, and other persons, as the legislature
16 designate.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
