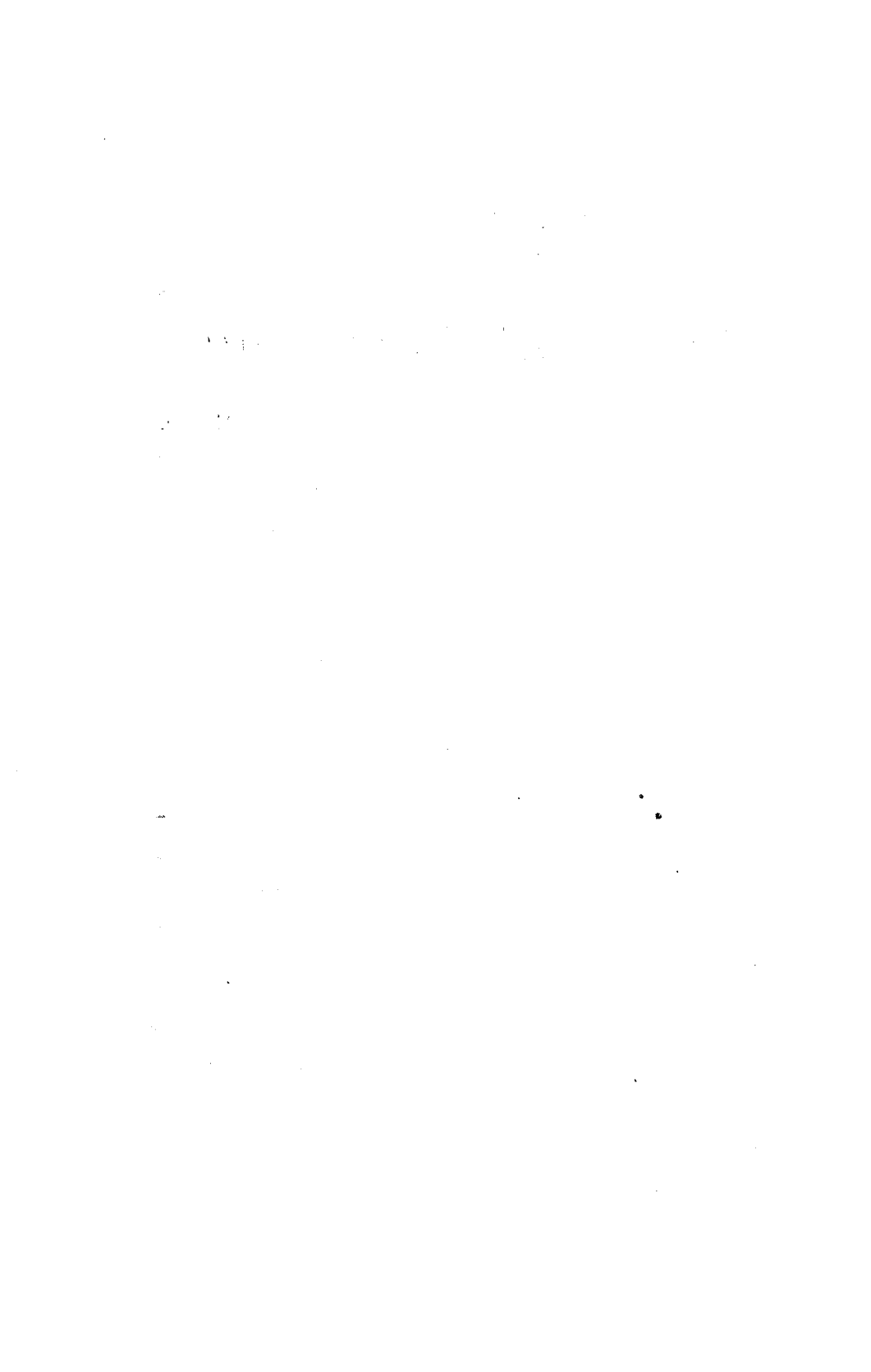
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT authorizing women to be admitted as attorneys to
practice law in the courts of this State.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. No person shall be denied admission or license to
2 practice as an attorney at law on account of sex.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on approval.
