STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT authorizing the Trustees of the Ministerial Fund in the Congregational Society in Buxton to apply the Interest of said Fund toward the Payment of the Minister's Salary.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. From and after the passage of this act the 2 trustees of the ministerial fund in the Congregational society 3 in Buxton, in the county of York and their successors are
- 4 hereby authorized to apply the annual interest only, accru-
- 5 ing from said ministerial fund to the annual support of the
- 6 Congregational minister who may now be settled in said
- 7 society or who may hereafter be settled there; and so long
- 8 as said society shall remain without a settled minister the

9 annual interest aforesaid shall be put out at interest until 10 there be a settlement of a minister in that society, in accord11 ance with the provisions of an act of the general court of
12 Massachusetts, approved February 18, 1814.

- Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the 2 above act are hereby repealed.
 - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
