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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT  
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

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AN ACT authorizing the Trustees of the Ministerial Fund in  
the Congregational Society in Buxton to apply the Interest  
of said Fund toward the Payment of the Minister's Salary.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. From and after the passage of this act the  
2 trustees of the ministerial fund in the Congregational society  
3 in Buxton, in the county of York and their successors are  
4 hereby authorized to apply the annual interest only, accru-  
5 ing from said ministerial fund to the annual support of the  
6 Congregational minister who may now be settled in said  
7 society or who may hereafter be settled there; and so long  
8 as said society shall remain without a settled minister the

9 annual interest aforesaid shall be put out at interest until  
10 there be a settlement of a minister in that society, in accord-  
11 ance with the provisions of an act of the general court of  
12 Massachusetts, approved February 18, 1814.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the  
2 above act are hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
