STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT for the Better Protection of Ship Masters and Seamen.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Whoever entices or persuades, or attempts to 2 entice or persuade, or aids, assists, or attempts to aid or assist,
- 3 a member of the crew of any vessel arriving in or about to
- 4 sail from a port in this State to leave or desert such vessel
- 5 before the expiration of his term of service therein, shall for-
- 6 feit a sum not exceeding one hundred dollars for each
- 7 offence, and be punished by imprisonment for not more than
- 8 six months nor less than thirty days, at the discretion of the 9 court.
- Municipal courts and trial justices shall have 2 original jurisdiction in all cases arising under this act.
