STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to fix the Salaries of the Judge and Register of
Probate for the County of Waldo.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. From and after the first day of January in the
2 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-
3 nine, the salary of the judge of probate for the county of
4 Waldo shall be five hundred dollars per year instead of the
5 sum now fixed by law.

Sect. 2. From and after the first day of January in the
2 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-
3 nine, the salary of the register of probate for the county of
4 Waldo shall be six hundred dollars per year instead of the
5 sum now fixed by law.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
