STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend Section 7 of Chapter 11 of the Revised Statutes relating to the duties of the Governor and Council in regard to Payment to Towns of State School Fund and Mill Tax.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section seven of chapter eleven of the Revised

- 2 Statutes is hereby amended by adding after the last word in
- 3 the second line of said section seven the words 'or to examine
- 4 teachers as prescribed by law, or to have instruction given in
- 5 the subjects prescribed by law, or to provide suitable text-
- 6 books in the subjects prescribed by law,' so that said section
- 7 seven shall read as follows:

'Section 7. When the governor and council have reason to 9 believe that a town has neglected to raise and expend the 10 school money required by law, or to examine teachers as pre11 scribed by law, or to have instruction given in the subjects 12 prescribed by law or to provide suitable text-books in the sub13 jects prescribed by law, or faithfully to expend the school 14 money received from the state, they shall direct the treasurer 15 of state to withhold further payment to such town from the 16 state school fund and mill tax until such town satisfies them 17 that it has expended the full amount of school money required 18 by law.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
