STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT relating to the Jurisdiction of Municipal and Police
Courts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. A municipal or police court shall not have
2 jurisdiction in any civil matter unless the defendant or a
3 party summoned as trustee resides within the county in
4 which such court is established. This act shall not enlarge
5 the jurisdiction of any municipal or police court under acts
6 heretofore passed for the establishment thereof.
