STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the commissioners appointed by the governor to inquire into and report upon the advisabilty of establishing additional state normal schools.

Resolved, That the State treasurer be directed to pay to
2 Frederick S. Walls, chairman of the commission appointed
3 by the governor to inquire into and report upon the advisa-
4 bility of establishing additional state normal schools, the
5 sum of three hundred and seventy dollars, the same being
6 the amount paid out for expenses by said commissioner.
