STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Waldo Street Railway.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section one of chapter 511, of the Private and
2 Special Laws of 1897, is hereby amended by striking out all
3 of said section after the word "that" in the 58th line, and
4 inserting in place thereof the following: 'Said corporation
5 is hereby authorized to cease running its cars, either by
6 electricity or animal power, during such portion of the win-
7 ter months, as it may be impracticable to operate said rail-
8 road on account of snow.'

Sect. 2. Section four of said act is hereby amended by
2 striking out in the last line, the words "one thousand eight

3 hundred and ninety-seven” and inserting in place thereof
4 the words ‘nineteen hundred and one.’

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
