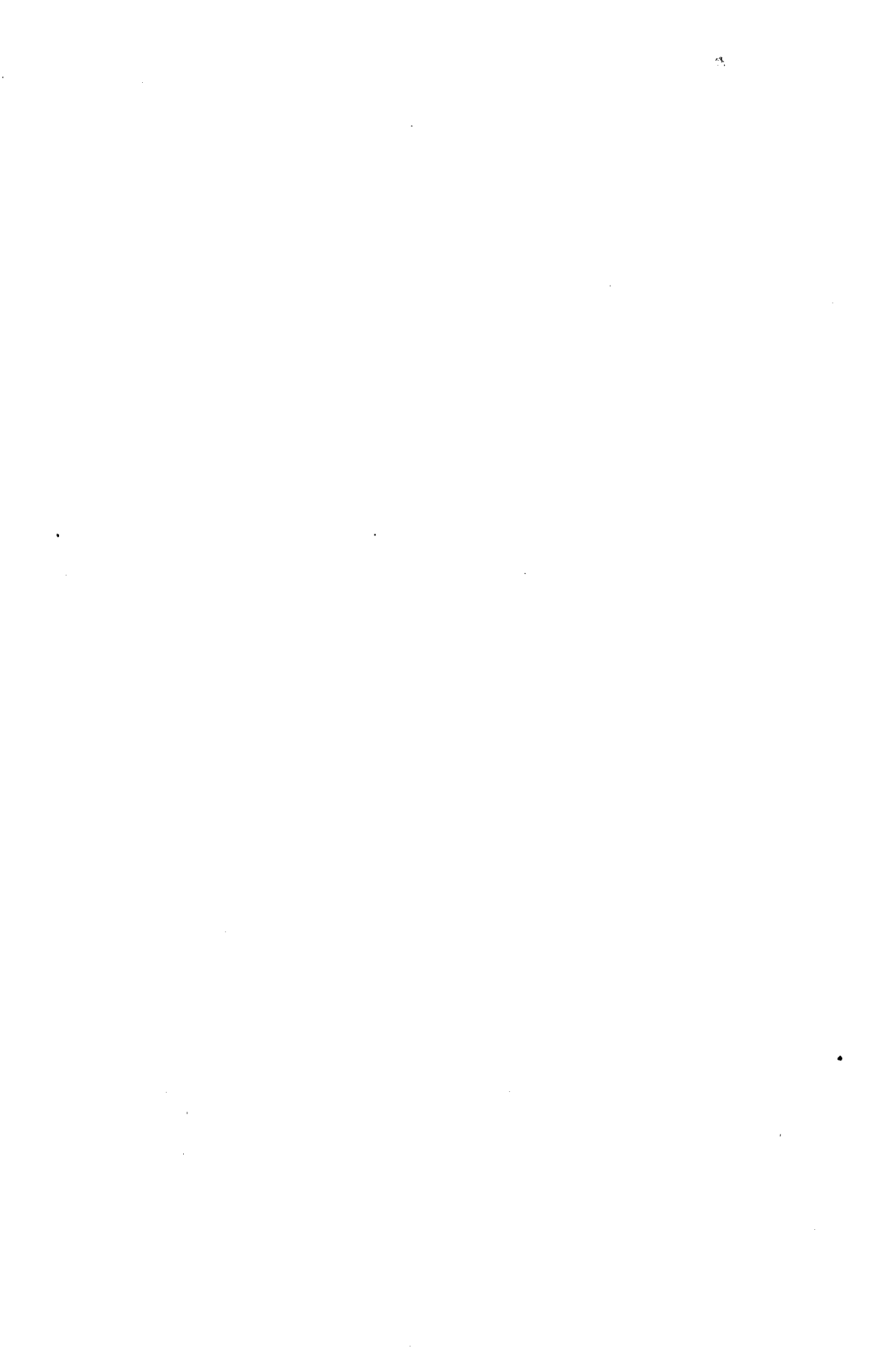
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Cumberland County to place the City of South Portland and the Town of Cape Elizabeth in a Jury District.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The county commissioners of Cumberland
2 county shall forthwith place the city of South Portland and
3 the town of Cape Elizabeth in the jury district to which they
4 may now respectively belong, and jurors shall be duly appor-
5 tioned and drawn therefrom as provided by law.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
