## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to extend the provisions of the general statutes, to Street Railway Charters, relating to the Location of Tracks.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Any street railway corporation organized under a special

- 2 legislative act shall, in addition to their charter right have all
- 3 the right and powers conferred from time to time by general
- 4 laws of street railroad corporations, subject to the conditions,
- 5 limitations and restrictions thereby imposed.
