STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT to extend the provisions of the general statutes, to
Street Railway Charters, relating to the Location of Tracks.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Any street railway corporation organized under a special
2 legislative act shall, in addition to their charter right have all
3 the right and powers conferred from time to time by general
4 laws of street railroad corporations, subject to the conditions,
5 limitations and restrictions thereby imposed.
