## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE authorizing the Governor and Council to examine into and adjust certain claims of cities and towns, arising out of the late war with Spain.

---

*Resolved,* That the governor and council are hereby authorized  
2 to examine into all claims of cities and towns for reimbursement  
3 on account of aid furnished by said cities and towns to needy  
4 families of soldiers in the late war with Spain, and to pay such  
5 claims as in the discretion of said governor and council may  
6 seem wise, out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise  
7 appropriated.
