## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE authorizing the Governor and Council to examine into and adjust certain claims of cities and towns, arising out of the late war with Spain.

Resolved, That the governor and council are hereby authorized

- 2 to examine into all claims of cities and towns for reimbursement
- 3 on account of aid furnished by said cities and towns to needy
- 4 families of soldiers in the late war with Spain, and to pay such
- 5 claims as in the discretion of said governor and council may
- 6 seem wise, out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise
- 7 appropriated.
