STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

AN ACT for the better protection of Fish Weirs.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. No person except the owner or person in charge
2 of such weir shall set any net or seine within five hundred feet
3 of the mouth of any weir under a penalty of fifty dollars for
4 each offense.

Sect. 2. The owner or person in charge of any weir is
2 hereby permitted to use nets and seines in such weir.

Sect. 3. Fines and penalties under this act may be recov-
2 ered by complaint, indictment or action of debt, for the use
3 of the county where the proceedings are commenced and
4 prosecuted.
