IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT  
HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE.

---

AN ACT relating to the Sale of Real Estate of Corporations  
on Execution.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Real estate, or any interest therein, of any corporation not  
2 created for supplying cities or towns with water, nor for  
3 educational, religious, street lighting, telegraph, telephone,  
4 or any public purposes, may be seized and sold on execution  
5 at public auction, either as real estate of banks, or as rights  
6 of redeeming real estate mortgaged, are taken on execution  
7 and sold, without the execution creditor first exhausting his

8 remedy against the personal property of such corporation,  
9 and subject to the same right of redemption as is provided in  
10 either case. Seizure and sale by either of the methods pro-  
11 vided in this act pass to the purchaser, all the right, title and  
12 interest that the execution debtor has in such real estate at  
13 the time of such seizure, or had at the time of the attachment  
14 thereof on the original writ, subject to the debtor's right of  
15 redemption. This section does not repeal any other modes  
16 of levy of execution, or seizure and sale of corporation real  
17 estate on execution.
