STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to abolish the fees and per diem compensation and establish the Salary of the Stenographer of the Superior Court for the county of Kennebec.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- · Section 1. The salary of the stenographer of the superior
- 2 court for the county of Kennebec shall be \$1,300 per year,
- 3 payable quarterly on the first days of January, April, July and
- 4 October, which shall be in full for all services and fees of every
- 5 kind.

- Sect. 2. Whenever said stenographer shall make or tran2 scribe from his notes any copies of the judge's charge, testi3 mony of witnesses for parties calling for the same he shall
 4 charge the usual fee for such services to the party for whom
 5 he renders these services, and certify the same to the clerk of
 6 said court, and said clerk shall collect the same and pay them
 7 over to the county treasurer.
- Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act 2 so far as the superior court is concerned are hereby repealed.
