AN ACT to revive the Organization of the Trustees of the Parsonage Fund of Bucksport.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Edward Swazey, George Blodgett, O. P. Cun-2 ningham and E. B. Gardner, are hereby confirmed as trustees 3 of the parsonage fund at Bucksport, the record of their elec-4 tion having been lost.
- Sect. 2. Said trustees shall have power to fill the vacancy 2 caused by the decease of Ambrose White, and they and their 3 successors may supply all vacancies which may occur here-4 after, and may have and exercise all the powers incident by
- 4 after, and may have and exercise all the powers incident by 5 law to such trustees.
 - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
