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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ONE.

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AN ACT to revive the Organization of the Trustees of the  
Parsonage Fund of Bucksport.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Edward Swazey, George Blodgett, O. P. Cun-  
2 ningham and E. B. Gardner, are hereby confirmed as trustees  
3 of the parsonage fund at Bucksport, the record of their elec-  
4 tion having been lost.

Sect. 2. Said trustees shall have power to fill the vacancy  
2 caused by the decease of Ambrose White, and they and their  
3 successors may supply all vacancies which may occur here-  
4 after, and may have and exercise all the powers incident by  
5 law to such trustees.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
