## STATE OF MAINE.

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An Act to provide for printing and distributing ballots at the public expense, and to regulate voting for State and city elections."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 28 of chapter 102 of the Public Acts of 2 1891 entitled "An Act to provide for printing and distribut-3 ing ballots at the public expense, and to regulate voting for 4 State and city elections," is hereby amended by striking out 5 the word "eight" in the second line of said section, and sub-6 stituting therefor the word 'six,' so that said section as 7 amended shall read as follows:

### HOUSE-No. 11.

'Sect. 28. Meetings for the election of State, county and 9 municipal officers may be opened as early as six o'clock in 10 the forenoon, and in no case shall the polls be kept open later 11 than five o'clock in the afternoon, a notice of the time of 12 opening and closing shall be given in the warrant calling the 13 meeting.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
