STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Franklin, Somerset and Kennebec Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the

- 2 Franklin, Somerset and Kennebec Railway Company
- 3 which were granted by chapter four hundred and sixty-
- 4 seven of the Private and Special laws of the State of
- 5 Maine for the year one thousand eight hundred and
- 6 ninety-seven, are hereby extended to January one in the
- 7 year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and three;
- 8 and the persons named in said act, their associates and

- 9 successors shall have all the rights, powers and privileges
- 10 that were granted them by said act to be exercised in the
- 11 same manner and for the same purposes as specified in
- 12 said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
