STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to change in part the town line between the towns
of Mexico and Rumford in the county of Oxford.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The center of Swift river shall be the
2 division line between the towns of Mexico and Rumford
3 in the county of Oxford, between the following bounds,
4 viz: Commencing in the channel of the Androscoggin
5 river opposite the mouth of Swift river, where it empties
6 into the Androscoggin river, thence up and in the
7 center of the Swift river, between bank and bank to
8 the northerly line of land of the Rumford Falls Power

9 Company, which point is the southerly line of the Fred
10 A. Porter farm, thence by the most direct line to the
11 present town line.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
