STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

RESOLVES providing for the preservation of Regimental
Rolls in the Adjutant General's office.

Resolved, That the adjutant general is hereby author-
2 ized and directed under the advice and control of the
3 governor and council to provide for the preservation of
4 the enlistment, descriptive and muster rolls, and the
5 monthly returns of the regiments and batteries in the War
6 of the Rebellion, now on file in the adjutant general's
7 office.

Resolved, That the sum of two thousand four hundred
9 dollars for the year nineteen hundred and one, and two
10 thousand four hundred dollars for the year nineteen hun-
11 dred and two, is hereby appropriated for the preserva-
12 tion of said rolls.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

These resolves are substantially a renewal of the resolves approved February 21, 1899, for two thousand four hundred dollars for each of the years eighteen hundred and ninety-nine and nineteen hundred. It has been found that this appropriation carried the work of preserving the rolls of the organizations from this State serving in the War of the Rebellion through a period of two years, making the cost two hundred dollars per month.
