STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Waldo Street Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the 2 Waldo Street Railway Company which were granted by 3 chapter two hundred and fifty-three of the Private and 4 Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one, as 5 amended by chapter six hundred and thirty-seven of the 6 Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-7 three, as amended by chapter three hundred and nine of

8 the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and

9 ninety-five, as amended by chapter five hundred and eleven 10 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and 11 ninety-seven, as amended by chapter one hundred and 12 thirty-two of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen 13 hundred and ninety-nine are hereby extended for two 14 years from the passage of this act and the persons named 15 in said act, their associates and successors shall have all 16 the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them 17 by said act, to be exercised in the same manner and for 18 the same purposes as specified in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
