## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend Section 47, of Chapter 77, of the revised statutes in relation to the terms of the Supreme Judicial Court in the County of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. After the first day of April in the present 2 year, the terms of the Supreme Judicial Court, within and 3 for the County of Oxford, shall be holden at Paris, in said 4 county, on the second Tuesday of October and on the 5 second Tuesday of March annually, instead of the terms 6 now provided by law, and the May term of court in said 7 county is hereby abolished. All recognizances and all 8 processes, either civil or criminal, shall be returnable

9 accordingly. All processes made returnable to and to 10 have day in said May term, in the present year, shall be 11 continued to and have day in the next term of said court, 12 held in said county, as if made returnable thereto. All 13 provisions of law inconsistent with this act are hereby 14 repealed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
