STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Wilson river in Piscataquis county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. There shall be an annual open season for 2 fishing in Wilson river in Piscataquis county between 3 Wilson pond, and Toby falls in the town of Willimantic by 4 any of the methods prescribed by law, from May fifteenth 5 to October first.

- Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.
 - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
