AN ACT to regulate fishing in Wilson river in Piscataquis  
county.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. There shall be an annual open season for  
2 fishing in Wilson river in Piscataquis county between  
3 Wilson pond, and Toby falls in the town of Willimantic by  
4 any of the methods prescribed by law, from May fifteenth  
5 to October first.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this  
2 act are hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
