IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the construction of a wharf into the tide waters of Penobscot river in Bucksport.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Edward L. Beazley is hereby authorized to

- 2 erect and maintain a wharf from the shore front of his
- 3 land known as the Farnham Store Lot in Bucksport,
- 4 Hancock county, and to extend the same into the tide
- 5 waters of Penobscot river.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
