IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to open Lambert lake, Washington county, to ice
fishing.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. So much of section five of chapter 30 of the
2 Revised Statues, as amended by chapter 42 of the Public
3 Laws of 1899, as prohibits ice fishing in Lambert lake, in
4 Washington county, is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
