STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to prohibit ice fishing in Bunganeaut pond, situated
in Alfred and Lyman, York county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. There shall be a close time in which it shall
2 be unlawful to fish for any kind of fish, in any way, at any
3 time, in Bunganeaut pond, situated in the towns of Alfred
4 and Lyman, York county, from the first day of October to
5 to the first day of the following May of each year.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to a penalty of ten dollars for each offense,
3 and one dollar for each fish caught, taken or killed in viola-
4 tion thereof.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
