STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend section 6 of chapter 267 of the Public Laws of 1893, entitled "An Act to provide for the Printing and Distributing Ballots at the Public Expense and to regulate voting for State and City Elections."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Said section 6 is hereby amended by striking out 2 the words: "at least thirty days, exclusive of Sundays, pre-3 vious to the day of the election for which the candidates 4 are nominated" and inserting the following: 'on or before 5 the tenth day in August of each year in which such election 6 is held,' so that said section as amended shall read as fol-7 lows:

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Sect. 6. Certificates of nomination and nomination papers, 9 for the nomination of candidates for state and county of-10 ficers and representatives to the legislature, shall be filed 11 with the secretary of State on or before the tenth day in 12 August of each year in which such election is held. Such 13 certificates and papers for the nomination of candidates for 14 the offices of mayor and all other offices in cities shall be 15 filed with the city clerks of the respective cities at least 16 seven days, exclusive of Sundays, previous to the day of 17 such election. With nomination papers and certificates 18 shall also be filed the consent in writing of the person nom-19 inated.
