STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT additional to chapter three hundred and thirty-three of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, relating to the United Gas and Electric Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The United Gas and Electric Company is 2 hereby authorized to acquire, by purchase or otherwise, 3 the franchises and property of the Dover Gas Light Com-4 pany and the Berwick Power Company and upon the 5 acquisition of the same, to have, exercise and enjoy all 6 the powers and privileges of said corporations subject, 7 however, to all their duties and liabilities.

- Sect. 2. Said corporation, in order to refund its present 2 indebtedness and to procure funds for the purchase of the 3 aforesaid properties, is hereby authorized to issue its bonds 4 in an amount not exceeding five hundred thousand dollars, 5 and secure the same by a mortgage upon its property and 6 franchises, now owned or hereafter acquired by it.
 - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
